- 3. What it would mean for you to meet the author.

Type the essay on white paper, 8 1/2" x 11" using 12 point font.

- No title is required.
- Check spelling, punctuation, and grammar carefully. Mistakes will disqualify the entry.
- Attach the completed Contest Entry Form (below and on our website: http://focalcentral.org/ documents/FOCAL-EssayContest2019.pdf) to the essay.
